MukaMunya Club – Summary of Rules and Regulations

Section of MM Club Rules and Regulations	Summary of key provisions
Article I Legal Structure and management	<p>MukaMunya Club (“MM Club”) is a division of the MukaMunya Homeowners Association (“MHOA”), a non-profit association registered under the Societies Act</p> <p>The authority overseeing the MHOA including the MM Club is the Executive Committee (“EC”) elected by the Homeowners</p>
Article II The Monkey Pools Recreational Subcommittee	<p>Provides for the establishing of a Recreational Subcommittee of the MHOA</p> <p>Will consist of 5 members appointed by the EC of the MHOA</p> <p>The Chairperson of the Subcommittee will be a member of the EC of the MHOA</p> <p>Will be responsible for developing and overseeing the activities programmes of the MM Club</p>
Article III Membership	<p>Specifies the categories of membership: Homeowners and outside members comprising: Residents; Non-residents; and Corporate</p> <p>Homeowners are automatically members</p> <p>Non homeowners may apply for outside membership</p> <p>Membership privileges will be suspended if homeowners fall more than 2 months in arrears on levies or if outside members are not fully paid up on their membership fees</p> <p>Both homeowner and outside members will be issued with membership cards and there will be registers and access controls at the gates</p>
Article IV Objectives and values	<p>Providing members and guests with an exceptional experience</p> <p>Achieving a full vibrant membership whilst maintaining a strong financial position</p> <p>Built on foundation values of: respect, integrity, family orientation, sound environmental practices, sense of ownership by members, and preservation of unique ecology of Monkey Pools</p>
Article V Private functions by members at Monkey Pools	<p>Monkey Pools is primarily for the use and enjoyment of members. Private non commercial functions will be allowed subject to terms and conditions:</p> <p>Private function application form must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the date of the function</p> <p>Private functions of up to 20 persons may be held anywhere in the amenities area, including the Clubhouse and normal rules and charges for guests will apply</p> <p>Private functions of over 20 and under 100 persons may be held at a designated area close to the Clubhouse. Charges will be determined from time to time by the EC.</p> <p>Private functions of over 100 persons may be allowed exceptionally at the discretion of the EC for private (non-commercial) purposes but subject to stringent environmental conditions being met. Charges will be determined from time to time by the EC.</p> <p>Members are restricted to 4 functions per annum and they must be fully paid up on levies and fees to be eligible to hold a private function</p>
Article VI General rules	<p>These Rules and Regulations may be amended or repealed at any meeting of the EC of the MHOA and any such changes shall be communicated promptly to all members</p> <p>Members must sign a register on arrival</p> <p>No pets are allowed</p> <p>Must abide by rules governing use of mobile phones and tablets</p> <p>Must abide by the Club dress code and the non smoking code</p> <p>Must indemnify the Club in respect of personal injury, damage to or loss of property</p>
